As a follow up to our previous emails, you may now choose your child's courses for the 2020-2021 school year through the secure MOZAIK website.



## **MOZAIK - COURSE SELECTION GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL LEVELS**

1. Course Selection is made up of **Assigned, Required and /or Option** courses that you must choose from.
2. Being a web site, you just need to click on each selection in order of preference.
3. Where there are only two choices, the first choice you click on is your default #1, and the remaining choice is automatically registered as your second.
4. For Arts Activity, please click on your choices in order of preference, 1 through 4. Whenever possible your first choice is given to you, but as this process is on a first come, first served basis, your alternate choices are considered firm commitments.
5. A complete timetable is **36 periods** and you will not be able to click on the button to confirm your choices until that number has been achieved.
6. All placements are re-evaluated pending final June results.
7. Any course or program with an enrolment under 20 is subject to cancellation. Alternate choices are considered firm commitments.
8. **You may not modify your choices online once they have been made, so choose carefully!**
9. Students that do not complete their course selection will be assigned their courses for next year based on availability.
10. **DEADLINE FOR COMPLETED COURSE SELECTION:  
FEBRUARY 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020**


## Steps to follow:

1. Be sure to use the MOZAIK website and not the ETSB Parent Portal.
2. Click the **LOG IN** button on the top of the page.

5. Enter your email address and Password in the appropriate boxes.

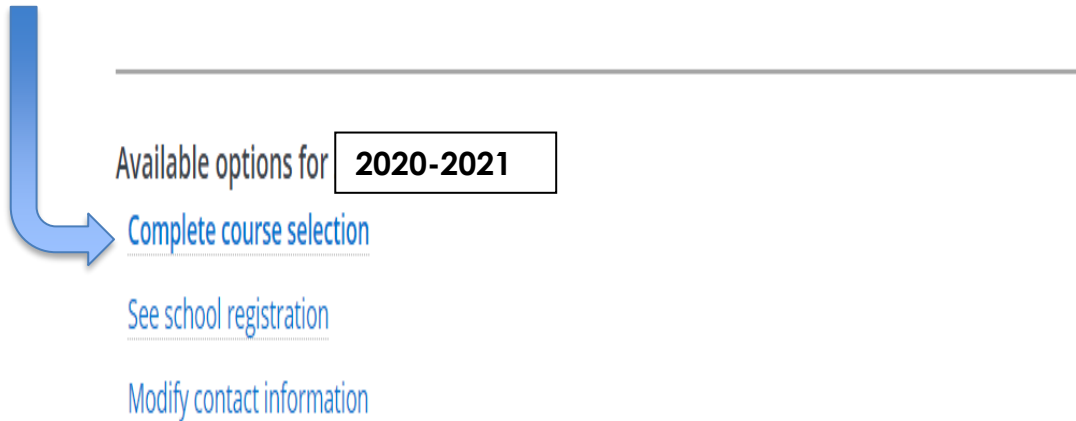

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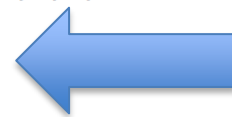
