Dear Parents of Secondary IV and Secondary V Students,

Your child will have access to their term 2 Massey-Vanier report card at the beginning of July on the Mozaik portal. Please note the results on this report card do not include exam results for Quebec Ministry of Education (MEQ) exams. Consequently, the Massey-Vanier report card is not your child's official transcript of marks for Secondary IV or Secondary V.

Your child will receive, through the Mozaik portal, a transcript from the MEQ which will show the **final summative** result for your child in each subject. It is this transcript (not the Massey-Vanier report card) that indicates if your child has passed or failed a course. The MEQ offers supplemental exams in Secondary IV Science and Math as well as in Secondary V ELA and French. It is therefore important for your child to regularly check their Mozaik portal to see if the final results have been posted in order to determine if they should register for a MEQ supplemental exam and/or summer school.

We have attached a calendar of the MEQ's supplemental exam dates. These supplemental exams will be written at the school board office in Magog. The school board will be e-mailing students having course summative averages between 45% to 59% with information on the supplemental exam process.

This year, the Eastern Townships School Board is offering summer school through LEARN only in the Secondary IV and Secondary V courses that have MEQ supplemental exams. You will also find attached the LEARN offer of summer school sessions including the eligibility requirements for taking these sessions. **Registration deadline is July 7 at 3 PM.** Given that places are limited and are offered on a first come first serve basis, we suggest that you register as soon as possible if you suspect that your child will not be successful in one of the courses offered and would benefit from a review before the supplemental exam. The school board has been assured that students can register early and be reimbursed up to two days after the course begins, should they discover that they were successful. Please note, your child does not have to take the summer school sessions to write the supplemental MEQ exams.

As a final point of information, please note that the government is not offering a supplemental exam in Secondary IV History. As a result, the only way your child has the possibility of passing Secondary IV History in the summer is by doing the summer school session with LEARN.
